Support the Breast and Cervical Cancer Program for underprivileged women at the Ormylia Foundation, Center for Disease Prevention, "Panagia Philanthropini," in northern Greece.

Panagia Philanthropini provides specialized cancer tests to underprivileged women, regardless of race, religion or nationality.

Panagia Philanthropini provides **free** breast and cervical cancer screening for **7,000 underprivileged women per year**. Remote, underserved populations are especially targeted. "For immigrants from Eastern Europe, the Middle East and Africa, these services are totally unavailable given the cultural barriers that exist," quotes a recent write up in Reuters and Yahoo. "The cultural traditions of the Turkish-speaking Muslims, Pomaks and Roma have even greater obstacles. This service reaches out to women who are under served with great love and care." Every year 20-25 breast cancers and 10-15 cervical cancers are detected at very early stages. Finding cancer so early in its development means it can be cured. The five year survival rate for Ormylia cancer patients is more than 95%.

Patient Stories:

Maria Lanatavou* is a dentist from a seaside village of Chalcidike. She was tested positive for breast cancer: "I came with the women from our village not thinking anything was wrong. The doctors of the Center called me in after my mammogram and told me that they found a very small tumour the size of a sesame seed. They made arrangements for me to go to the hospital the next day. I went and was operated on. The surgeon took out the tumour with just a small amount of tissue from around it, making my scar small. After the operation the doc told me that my cancer was caught in good time and that my life would be normal after some limited chemo-therapy. In two days I was discharged. As I was leaving the room the nurse came in and asked me to wait for the doctor. I was so scared that something was wrong. He came in and told me not to worry. He simply asked 'where did you get this mammogram? I have never seen such a clear and pristine image.' I told him at Panagia Philanthropini...

Georgia Aeivazidou* is from the same village, she was diagnosed with cervical cancer in 1992. "The Center doctors sent me to the hospital immediately. The Sisters took care of the appointments for me. The surgeon told me that I would need a hysterectomy and that I was fortunate. 'Six more months and you would have been inoperable. Keep going to Panagia Philanthropini, their screening program saves many lives. You will be fine now.' That's why I keep coming, and why I keep telling women from the village to come to the Center in Ormylia to be screened. It is 2009 and I keep coming back faithfully for my testing..."
